
Virginia Senator Mark Warner

Dangerously Anti-ICE Anti-Law Enforcement Pro Illegals



This is the letter that Mark Warner is sending Virginians and what he's really telling us.



<u>Warner says:</u> In Virginia, since January, over 4,000 people have been arrested by ICE – a 500 percent increase from last year. In recent months, agents have been observed making arrests at courthouses, workplaces, shopping areas, and apartment complexes. Agents from ICE and agencies supporting ICE have been widely observed conducting immigration enforcement in plain clothes, out of unmarked cars, and while wearing full-face coverings and a variety of imprecise or inscrutable insignia that make them impossible to identify.

Read Between the lines: Warner seems to think this is a bad thing. Dems are losing voters. Too many Illegals being arrested. Law enforcement should flag their intent ahead of time so the illegals, rapists, murderers, child traffickers and MS-13 gang members can get away.

Warner says: This conduct poses a great risk for everyone involved, from the officers hemselves to well-intentioned bystanders who may misunderstand the situation. Communities around the country have been clear: we should not have armed, masked, and unidentified individuals prowling around neighborhoods and snatching people off the street. Despite the risks, our local police officers, state troopers, national guard personnel, and even members of the armed forces interact with communities every day with full-faced transparency – the kind that creates trust and helps hold us all to higher standards.

Read Between the lines: Warner seems to think that pandering to illegals is more Important that keep our communities safe.

Warner says: That is why I was proud to introduce the Immigration Enforcement Identification Safety (IEIS) Act of 2025. The bill would prohibit law enforcement officers from obscuring their faces and require that they clearly display their agency, their name and a unique identifier while conducting immigration enforcement functions, with some commonsense exceptions for

select tactical missions and officer health and safety. The bill also provides federal law enforcement agencies with the authority to better protect law enforcement officers and their families from doxing.

Read Between the lines: Warner not only wants law enforcement to "warn" illegals they are coming, but he wants law enforcement "UNMASKED" and "NAMED" with a "UNIQUE IDENTIFIER" so the Soros funded paid protesters can harass the agents and their families more easily. Does anyone recall Warner filing legislation to unmask antifa, BLM, and ICE protesters as they burn cities and federal buildings down?
